Accessing your Formulary Drug List

The drug formulary is your official list of all drugs covered by your prescription plan. To access your formulary and learn more about your coverage, please follow the steps below:

- Visit southernscripts.net/members
- Select Find Your Member Page on the left navigation
- Enter your Group Number: (Found on your Insurance/Rx card) 3.
- Select View Member Page
- Under Search For Medications, type the name of your medication and click Search

Accessing your Member Portal


The Southern Scripts Member Portal is home to essential benefit information, such as member and dependent details, benefit utilization, and plan utilization. You can also browse your prescription drug history and locate a pharmacy near you.

- Visit southernscripts.net/members
- Select Member Portal on the left navigation
- Login to the Pharmacy Benefits Portal with your credentials. Note: First time users need to create an account by following the hyperlink on the Member Portal page.



Save Money by Locating a FirstChoice™ Pharmacy

- 1. Visit southernscripts.net/members
- 2. Select Find a Pharmacy
- 3. Enter your ZIP code
- 4. The Southern Scripts Bin Number is **015433**
- 5. Enter your **Group Code**: (Found on your Insurance/Rx card)
- 6. Select your search radius based on your ZIP code

How do I lower my prescription drug costs?

Locate a FirstChoice™ pharmacy by following the steps above

Remember: A participating FirstChoice™ pharmacy offers, on average, a lower cost on medications for covered drugs than a standard (non-preferred) pharmacy.

Ask your physician about generic drugs

A generic drug is a version of a brand drug. According to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA), compared to the brand drug, a generic:

- · is chemically the same
- works the same in the body
- is just as safe and effective
- meets the same standards set by the FDA
- · often costs much less

Example: rosuvastatin (generic) is the same drug as Crestor® (brand)



It is easy to transfer your prescriptions to a FirstChoice™ pharmacy

Locate a FirstChoice™ pharmacy by following the steps above

Remember: FirstChoiceTM (preferred) offers, on average, a lower cost on medications for covered drugs than a standard (non-preferred) pharmacy.

Contact your new participating FirstChoice™ pharmacy

Inform your new participating FirstChoice™ pharmacy that you want to transfer your prescriptions from your old pharmacy. You will need the name, strength, and prescription number of each prescription, along with the phone number of your old pharmacy. You can accomplish this by calling, visiting the new pharmacy in person, or if your new pharmacy offers the technology, by using online services such as a website or mobile app.

What information will the pharmacy need to facilitate the transfer?

Your new pharmacy will need your health insurance information, and perhaps some personal information as well. Typically, your new pharmacy will request:

- · Health insurance card
- First and last name
- · Date of birth
- Address
- · Phone number
- · Possible allergies you may have

How long will it take to complete the transfer?

The amount of time your new pharmacy needs can depend on how many prescriptions need to be moved over, possibly 1–3 business days. When the time comes to pickup your prescription(s), please bring your insurance card with you to the pharmacy.

Price Check Tool

The Drug Pricing Tool allows members to price their prescription drugs at any pharmacy in a few easy steps. To access the Drug Pricing tool, please follow the instructions below:

- 1. Visit southernscripts.net/members
- 2. Select Member Portal on the left navigation
- 3. Login to the Pharmacy Benefits Portal
- 4. Select **Pharmacy Locator** on the top navigation
- 5. Enter **Zip Code**

- 6. Select Search Radius
- 7. Locate your desired pharmacy and select the **Price Check** option (Refer to legend to the right for pharmacy details)

8. Enter drug name, desired quantity, and days supply for the drug
9. Select Search
